



COVID-19 Park Re-opening Guidelines and Waiver – May, 2020

Guidelines

The following guidelines shall apply for re-opening of the Westward Ho Campground and remain in place until further notice, with updates to be provided in writing, and are to be coordinated with AHS guidelines at all times:

1. All facilities at the Park, including shower houses, outhouses, laundry, hall, cook shacks, ball diamonds, beaches, off-leash dog area, playgrounds, horseshoe pits and all other public gathering areas shall remain closed.
2. Anyone wanting to use the Park may be asked to provide proof that the washroom facilities within their trailer are adequate; you must be able to adequately wash and provide for proper sewage disposal. As the on-site facilities will all initially be closed, use of in-trailer facilities is all that will be available.
3. Means of social distancing, as outlined by AHS requirements, must be maintained. Sites will be limited to a maximum number of people as appropriate to each site and as required per AHS guidelines as they are currently, and as they progressively get revised, accordingly.
4. Everyone is encouraged to bring everything they will need at the Park from home and all are discouraged from going into local communities.
5. Disinfectant will be provided by the Park, on a limited basis (as being subject to availability) at spigots and dump stations wherever possible; you are encouraged to sanitize contact surfaces before and after use. Members are to provide their own PPE (gloves, masks, etc.) as needed for utilizing the Park.
6. Wherever possible, when entertaining guests from other sites, host sites are to provide means for guests to wash or sanitize their hands accordingly.
7. Only vehicles with valid identification placards and valid access passes shall be allowed in the Park; such placards/passes are to be visible at all times. Distancing with staff is to be maintained, and arrangements are to be made with Park Staff, ideally via phone or e-mail, to arrange receipt of your 2020 placards.
8. Outside visitors are not permitted at this time. This defines that camping shall be limited to those that regularly camp on your site and live within the same household. Tents are also not to be added to sites at this time.
9. Self-isolation or quarantining as required in relation to COVID-19 shall be done at home, NOT at the Park; the Park is NOT an alternative "home" for such purposes.
10. Services such as trailer repair, wood delivery, gravel delivery, etc. must be coordinated through Park Management.
11. All interactions with the Park Staff will happen at a distance; the office will remain closed to campers and any questions, etc. will be encouraged to take place via phone. No transactions will be allowed in cash; only debit, credit and e-transfers will be accepted. Such transactions can include, but are not limited to, fees payments, ice purchases and in-campground wood supply orders.
12. Children 12 and under who are away from their site of use shall be under the guidance of a responsible adult, or appointed responsible teenager, at ALL times. Children 13-17 are to be made aware of all guidelines and waivers, and are to conduct themselves accordingly at all times.

Waiver

Use of the Park is always at your own risk; use of the Park is voluntary and is not deemed a necessity or essential service. Your use of the Park shall waive all liability and/or legal responsibility held by the Park, either directly or indirectly associated with damage, illness (including contraction of COVID-19) or injury resulting from use thereof. Proper conduct, self-guidance and adherence to AHS guidelines is strongly encouraged at all times.
